

BIDEN'S INAUGURATION – CELEBRATIONS

An emotional Lady Gaga performed a dramatic version of the U.S. national anthem, Garth Brooks sang a cappella, and Tom Hanks hosted a star-studded nighttime celebration to cap President Joe Biden's inauguration.

ON A DAY marked by diversity and appeals for unity, Gaga made an entrance in a huge fuchsia Schiaparelli couture silk skirt and blacktop adorned by a large gold brooch of a dove carrying an olive branch as she sang 'The Star-Spangled Banner' at President Biden's swearing-in ceremony. Gaga at one point also gestured to the US flag flying high over the Capitol, the seat of Congress that just two weeks ago was attacked by supporters of outgoing President Donald Trump seeking to overturn Biden's election victory.

Ahead of her performance, Gaga said on Twitter she wanted to "acknowledge our past, be healing for our present, and be passionate for a future where we work together lovingly." Country singer Brooks, a Republican, chose jeans and a black shirt and took off his black Stetson hat to sing an unaccompanied version of 'Amazing Grace', asking all the Americans at the ceremony and watching at home to sing the last verse along with him. Jennifer Lopez, dressed in white pants and a long matching coat,

performed a medley of 'This Land is Your Land' and 'America The Beautiful', interjecting in Spanish the part of the US Pledge of Allegiance that says, "One nation, under God, indivisible, with liberty and justice for all."

At just 22 years old, poet Amanda Gorman captured the mixed emotions of the past four years with a poem in which she referred to herself as a "skinny Black girl, descended from slaves and raised by a single mother (who) can dream of becoming president only to find herself reciting for one." The beautiful cultural celebrations continued all of Wednesday night with a broadcast across television and social media, hosted by Tom Hanks, who is known as "America's Dad." The events, bringing together some of the biggest white, Black and Hispanic celebrities, marked a sharp contrast with Trump's inauguration in 2017, which was extremely low on star power. Wednesday's TV special, called "Celebrating America", opened with Bruce Springsteen, standing alone

with an acoustic guitar on the steps of the Lincoln Memorial, singing "Land of Hope and Dreams." Standing nearby, Hanks acknowledged "deep division and a troubling rancor" in recent years, but said "tonight we ponder the United States of




America... and the hopes and dreams we all share for a more perfect union." Other performers included John Legend, Demi Lovato and country singers Tim McGraw and Tyler Hubbard, who paired for a song about unity called "Undivided". Delivery drivers, healthcare workers and others also told stories of perseverance during the coronavirus pandemic. Foo Fighters singer Dave Grohl, the son of a public school teacher, dedicated a song to "all of our unshakable teachers." The wonderful show concluded with Katy Perry, in a white gown with blue and red trim, singing her hit "Firework". Biden and his wife, Jill, watched from the White House as fireworks lit up the sky around the capital city's monuments. What a beautiful day it was. ■



Earlier in August, while speaking of the challenges she faced during her time in the hospital under treatment, Jamil shared that at one point she felt like giving up and even "attempted suicide, but failed." "I cried a lot when my hair was cut off. But I felt proud and saw myself as a strong woman when I first looked at myself with a bald head in the mirror," she went on to share that "my journey with cancer has made me much stronger".

To honour his legacy, QB tweeted saying, "Naseer Turabi's passing is a loss but he will live in our hearts forever."



HE WAS 75-years-old and has been laid to rest at Wadi-a-Hussain graveyard. Born on June 15, 1945, in Hyderabad Deccan, pre-partition India, Turabi and his family migrated to Pakistan






PAKISTAN TO GET SINOPHARM VACCINE BY EARLY FEBRUARY

Health minister says 500,000 people to benefit from 1st batch of COVID-19 vaccine




THE FIRST batch of COVID-19 jabs from the Chinese vaccine manufacturing company Sinopharm will arrive in Pakistan by the first week of February, according to reports. Dr. Faisal Sultan, a special assistant to the prime minister on health, said the "first installment of 1.1 million doses for about 500,000 people" will be received from Sinopharm.

Sultan, who is also the acting health minister, had earlier mentioned that authorities were negotiating with China and Russia, among others, to procure the vaccines, and that front-line workers and senior citizens will be inoculated first. Pakistan has so far recorded a total of 504,293 cases of COVID-19 with 10,676 deaths. Immunization has already begun in EU countries, the US, UK, and many Gulf states. The vaccines approved so far include the ones produced by BioNTech/Pfizer and Moderna. Pakistan will launch the vaccination drive in the second quarter of this year, Nausheen Hamid, the parliamentary secretary at the Health Ministry, announced late last month. Here's hoping to a safer future. ■

“We have been working really hard to bring the best out in the music” he added.



SHARMEEN OBAID CHINOY AMONG '18 BEST FILM DIRECTORS OF ASIA'



THE LIST ALSO features the likes of Academy Award winning director Bong Joon-Ho, who is also the jury president of the 78th Venice International Film Festival. The list also features Park Chan-wook, Wong Kar-wai, Hou Hsiao-hsien, and Antoinette Jadaone among other remarkable filmmakers from Asia. Joon-Ho's "Parasite" (2019) became the first South Korean film to win Best International Feature Film and Best Picture at the Oscars in 2020, bringing him worldwide fame. Now, Chinoy feels elated to have been featured along such critically acclaimed and renowned names. "Now that's a cool list to be a part of! Thank you @tatlerhongkong. outlet read: "Sharmeen Obaid-Chinoy wears a lot of hats. She's a journalist, an activist and also a filmmaker, most known for her work that put the spotlight on the inequality that women face. Because of this, she has received two Academy Awards, six Emmy Awards and a Knight International Journalism Award. To honour her achievements and contributes, the Government of Pakistan bestowed her the Hilal-i-Imtiaz, the second-highest civilian honour in the country in 2012. The

same year, she was named one of the 100 most influential people in the world by Time magazine. Obaid-Chinoy is also the first female director to have two Academy Awards at just 37 years old." "Her award-winning film includes the documentary, Saving Face (2012) and the biographical A Girl in the River: The Price of Forgiveness (2015). The latter was so impactful that after seeing the film, the Pakistani prime minister said that he will change the law on honour killing after seeing it." ■



THE LEADING RECONSTRUCTIVE AND AESTHETIC Surgeon

We had the chance to sit down with one of the best plastic, reconstructive and aesthetic surgeon in Pakistan – Dr OBT! Here is what we got to know about him and his practice.

GROOMING TARIQ AMIN STYLIST YASAR AZIZ

Grazia: Tell us how you got into this field!

Dr OBT: The earliest memory of my desire to become a medical doctor was when I was walking in a park with my grandfather, aged 8. He asked me what I wanted to become when I grew up, and I instantly replied, “a doctor!” He asked me why, and I responded “because I want to help people”. The journey was long, full of challenges and setbacks. My family and life-partner always supported me, and believed in me. I became the first doctor of my generation on both sides of the family, and then the real


struggles began. I enjoyed surgery, and the concept of reconstructing limbs after trauma, burn care and repairing congenital facial deformities was something I found extremely interesting. I went to the UK after my house-job, and completed my basic surgical training for two years. After that, I completed my post-graduate residency in Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery which took another six years. Following that, I pursued fellowships in aesthetic surgery, travelled to South America, Singapore and Turkey. I always had passion to learn, and enjoyed the fact

that this was the most innovative and exciting field in medicine. With plastic surgeons now involved in stem cells and regenerative therapy with potential to benefit all other fields of medicine, I know now that I made the right choice! With over 17 years of surgical experience, and over a dozen years in private practice, I can say that I have arrived.

Grazia: What is the most common work that is performed at your clinic at the moment?

Dr OBT: We have evolved into a complete medical centre. Halcyon





Medical Centre is celebrating its tenth year, and we have relocated to a larger and purpose-built medical facility. We have an outpatient department with multiple specialists, diagnostic radiology such as x-ray and ultrasound, a laboratory and pharmacy. Our main area of expertise is aesthetic medicine, aesthetic plastic surgery, lasers and skin care. However, having had success in these areas, our patients wanted us to widen our scope as they appreciated the healthcare standards we followed in our practice. Currently, skin treatments, lasers, facial sculpting and body contouring are most popular.

Grazia: Can you tell us some dos and dont's of plastic surgery?

Dr. OBT: Never trust your face or body with someone who is not properly qualified. Always choose a specialist, who has spent extra training in the field and has a keen interest in what he or she does. I strongly believe that you cannot be great at something you are not passionate about. Hence, investigate

your doctor's credentials, training, results and word of mouth always helps! What you should not do is trust any new shiny, glossy place just because it looks luxurious! This is medicine. This field requires regulation, high clinical standards and regular monitoring by authorities. Unfortunately, in Pakistan, there is a lack of awareness but slowly thanks to social media things are changing.

Grazia: Tell us the new trend these days, are fillers still something that people are opting for?

Dr. OBT: Trends come and go, I never follow them and I advise my patients not to believe everything they see. Being a specialist, before I offer a new treatment in my practice I do my research and let it be around for a while to see how successful it really is. I like to practice evidence-based medicine, which means unless there is a lot of scientific proof, I do not do it! Fillers are surely one of many nonsurgical solutions to rejuvenate the face, or provide contour and

balance. I am currently enjoying stem cell therapy, which is basically extracted from your own fat! We can use these to slow down facial aging, and to augment the body. There is never really that one treatment which gives all of the results! I am a bit of a holistic practitioner, I believe in wellness, healthy food choices and mental health. I believe the greatest impact is when you actually do everything right... consistently! It takes a lot of effort to look and feel good. In order for one to have healthy and radiant skin, for example, is like being in a marathon and not a race!

Grazia: Tell us some tips and tricks of keeping our skin from aging poorly.

Dr. OBT: Use sunscreen regularly. Eat plenty of antioxidant rich foods, stay well hydrated and sleep well. Consult with a competent doctor who can help you with keeping your skin, and overall appearance. The aim should be to look fresh and healthy. A good home skin care regime combined with the right clinical skin treatments can deliver very good results, which you have to


maintain. My line OBT Skin Health is fast growing, since 2015, and will be available globally.

Grazia: How would you differentiate yourself from the many other clinics offering similar services?

Dr. OBT: When I began my practice, there were many dermatologists who were doing government jobs and spending a few hours in the evening doing some aesthetic treatments. This, to me, looked like a half-hearted approach. Plastic surgeons never performed any nonsurgical treatments, and nobody practiced aesthetics full time. I was the first qualified plastic surgeon with a masters degree in Aesthetic Plastic Surgery (from the UK), and fellowships in Aesthetic surgery. I practiced full time in aesthetic medicine and surgery. Nowadays we have what I call 'fast-track doctors' who spend a few days doing courses, and then open up their clinics to begin practicing on faces. My rigorous training, advanced qualifications and visits to leading experts around the world enabled me to perform well in my field, Allhamdulillah.

Grazia: What type of clients do you have?

Dr. OBT: My clients are a mixture of



students, professionals, housewives and visitors from overseas. Lately, we see a lot of men coming in due to hair loss, body contouring and acne/ acne scars. On a typical day, I perform lets say a rhinoplasty, and a tummy-tuck, along with injectables such as botox and fillers, peels, lasers for scars and lastly consultations. My clients range from 3 month old babies for cleft lip repair, to 75 year olds who want a face and neck lift! I am blessed to be able to care for, and help people, and I take pride in my work ethic which I inherited from my father.

Grazia: Why are you called Dr. OBT and who is the real Osman Bashir Tahir?

Dr. OBT: My colleagues used to call me this during my residency training years, and it just stuck! Its become a kind of alter-ego for me, and so when I am at work I am a totally different

person. Even if a family member visits me at work they find me too serious, which I explain as me being professional! The real Osman Bashir Tahir is a family man, who adores his wife and children and tries to spend as much time as he can with his parents, elders and friends as he possibly can! I do enjoy travelling, going to the gym, reading and watching Netflix!

Grazia: What lies in the future for Dr.OBT?

Dr. OBT: I am old school in the sense that I just follow my belief in hard work! I believe everything and anything is possible, hence I focus on what is in front of me and I try to get the job done in the best way possible. I strongly believe that the best is yet to come, InshAllah, and I don't believe in limitations. I have future goals, but right now I just want to be thankful to the Almighty, and to enjoy my time in the sun... ■





10 MODELS THAT RULED THE FASHION SCENE IN 2020




ABEER RIZVI


MUNSIFF ALI KHAN




ENOLA HOLMES


EMILY IN PARIS


A SUITABLE BOY


SABAAT




MENTAL HOOD


