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

### Britney Spears

speaks out
against 'abusive'
conservatorship
in court

US pop star Britney
Spears has launched a
blistering attack on the
"abusive" conservatorship
that has controlled her
life for 13 years.

SHE SAID she was traumatised and cried every day, telling a judge in Los Angeles: "I just want my life back".

Spears who is now 39, also said she had been denied the right to have more children and was put on the psychiatric drug lithium against her wishes.

Her father was granted control over her affairs by court order in 2008. The order was granted after the star was put in hospital amid concerns over her mental health, and it has





been extended for more than a decade since.

The special hearing recently was the first time Spears has spoken in open court about her case. Los Angeles Superior Court Judge Brenda Penny thanked Spears for her "courageous" words during the proceedings.


It followed much speculation about the pop star's situation, with fans eagerly combing her social media output for clues. A fan-led movement, known as #FreeBritney, has campaigned for her legal freedom for years.

Spears delivered an impassioned address which lasted for more than 20 minutes. She also added that she wished she could stay on the phone "forever" to avoid returning to her life

where she was surrounded by people who said no to her.

Spears told the court she wanted the conservatorship to end and described the arrangement as "embarrassing and humiliating".

# Quentin Tarantino to retire after his next film





Acclaimed Hollywood filmmaker Quentin
Tarantino has reiterated his desire to retire from Hollywood after his next film.

THE ACE director was talking to host Bill Maher on his HBO talk show Real Time with Bill Maher when he said he wants to take off now. Tarantino, whose novelisation of his last film Once Upon a Time in Hollywood releases on June 29, also revealed that he briefly considered directing a reboot of Reservoir Dogs but ended up rejecting the idea.

He told Maher, "I don't have a reason that I would want to say out loud...that's going to win any argument in a court of public opinion or Supreme Court or anything like that. At the same time, working for 30 years, doing as many films as I've done — it's not as many as other people, but like, that's a long career. That's a really long career. And I've given it everything I have, every single solitary thing I have."

He added, "I know film history and from here on in, filmmakers do not get better," implying that he wants to go out on a high.

The Oscar-winner went on to bring up the example of late filmmaker Don Siegel to illustrate his point.

"If he had quit his career in 1979, when he did Escape from Alcatraz... what a final film! What a mic drop. But he, like, dribbles away with two more other ones. He doesn't mean it," Tarantino tried to explain.

### DIAOR DIOR ON THE RAMP AFTER

The French couture house kicked off Paris fashion week with in-person runway show drawing elebrities to the ont-row

FRENCH COUTURE house Christian Dior kicked off Paris fashion week with an in-person runway show drawing celebrities to the front-row in an attempt to revive a touch of pre-pandemic glamour.

Actors Jessica Chastain, Cara Delevingne, Monica Bellucci and Florence Pugh were among the limited crowd who lined the catwalk at Dior's Fall/Winter 2021-2022 haute couture collection.

Designer Maria Grazia Chiuri told the reporters that she wanted fabrics to be front and centre. An audience in the room could appreciate the detail



and the tactile nature of the fabric in a way that does not come across online or in video footage.

Tweed ensembles, from jackets to hats resembling horse riding helmets, took the stage in a patchwork of muted tones.

Models showed vegetal prints on a velvet and satin coat. For evening looks, there were long skirts embroidered with feathers and sheer pleated long dresses in silk gauze.

With vaccinations progressing and lockdowns loosening, fashion is tiptoeing its way back to traditional catwalk shows, for now mixing live audiences and online presentation.

"We are all very emotional," said Chiuri.

"There are so many people that work on the collection. We were happy to realise beautiful films but it was just a little bit impersonal. [Everyone] is really proud to see the show, be backstage, live the moment with our clients, the press, our friends. In one year and a half, we lost a lot of these

human contacts," she said.

LVMH (LVMH.PA)-owned Dior staged the show in the gardens of Paris' Rodin museum inside a temporary structure covered with embroidery designed by the French artist Eva Jospin and made by Indian craftswomen.



## First-ever transgender school opens in Multan

THE PROVINCIAL education minister vowed that schools for the transgender community will be opened in all districts of Punjab. "One step at a time. Education for ALL," he added.

The school is now opened in Multan and celebs are lauding the government's efforts. "This is such a positive development," shared Tera Mukhra crooner Shehzad Roy. "I hope I live to see the day when transgenders get the right to choose which school they want to go to boys, girls, co-ed or separate transgender schools."

Ahsan Khan, too, praised the initiative. "The most vulnerable section of society being given the basic human rights, heartwarming indeed,"

Raas' tweet was in response to a story by a local publication on an announcement made by the minister while addressing a ceremony held regarding Insaf Afternoon School Programme (IASP) at a hotel in Lahore. The minister, at the event, said that the government decided not to enroll members of the transgender community in regular schools because of some reservations regarding the behaviour of other students. Raas noted that the attitude of students from regular schools could be insulting towards the transgender community, which is why separate schools were being set up for them.

Punjab Education Minister Murad Raas announced that the provincial government will open up the first-ever transgender school in Pakistan, in the city of Multan. "We are opening the first-ever transgender school in Pakistan. Why would we deny education to anyone in our country? Our first school is opening in Multan," tweeted the minister.



He said it was unfortunate that no government except for the Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) thought about the welfare and provision of education and jobs to the transgender community. The minister said registration for the schools is in progress and will be completed by July 15. ■

Meghan set to create animated Netflix series for girls

Britain's Duchess Meghan Markle has created an animated family series for streaming platform Netflix Inc that she will also executive produce.

ARCHEWELL Productions, the company formed by Meghan and her husband, Prince Harry, said in a statement the series would be centred on the adventures of a 12-year-old girl, who is inspired by a variety of influential women from history.

The series, called Pearl, is one of the first to be announced by Netflix and the British couple, formally known as



the Duke and Duchess of Sussex. They struck the deal last year after they quit their royal duties and moved to California.

"Like many girls her age, our heroine Pearl is on a journey of self-discovery as she tries to overcome life's daily challenges," Meghan said in a statement.

Meghan will executive produce the series along with David Furnish, the husband of British singer Elton John, the statement said. John is a close friend of Harry and Meghan and performed at their wedding reception in 2018.

The animated series follows the announcement last year of a Netflix project that is close to Harry's heart – a documentary series about the Invictus Games for wounded servicemen and women.

It follows the publication last month of Meghan's first book – The Bench – a children's story about fatherhood that she said was inspired by Harry's relationship with the couple's first child, Archie. Meghan gave birth to a daughter, Lilibet "Lili" Diana, in June.

Last year, the couple's first-ever
Netflix production was announced.
Harry will produce a documentary
about the Invictus Games for disabled
military veterans. Harry, who served
with the British military in Afghanistan,
will appear on camera and
executive-produce Heart of Invictus,
a multi-episode series that follows
competitors as they train for next
spring's competition in The Hague.

The 74-minute documentary examined the singer's meteoric rise to fame as a teenager, the ensuing media scrutiny and her widely publicized breakdown, as well as her life under the conservatorship and a fan movement known as #FreeBritney. The Baby One More Time singer has lived under a conservatorship overseen by her father since 2008, when she was hospitalised for psychiatric treatment. Last month, she told a Los Angeles court that the arrangement was abusive and she wanted it to end.

Winfrey's two-hour sit-down with Harry and Meghan in March sent shockwaves through the British monarchy when Meghan accused Britain's royal family of raising concerns about how dark their son's skin might be and of pushing her to the brink of suicide.

It aired on CBS and got an Emmy nomination in the best-hosted nonfiction series or special category.

In the best documentary series category, contenders include HBO's Allen v Farrow, which explored the allegation that film director Woody Allen sexually assaulted his daughter Dylan Farrow in 1992. Allen has repeatedly denied the allegations and called the series a "hatchet job."

The Emmy winners will be announced at a live televised ceremony in Los Angeles on Sept 19. ■



# 'TRAGEDY KING' - DILIP KUMAR

The legendary actor's family friend Faisal Farooqui announced on his Twitter, "With a heavy heart and profound grief, I announce the passing away of our beloved Dilip Saab, few minutes ago. We are from God and to Him we return."

IT IS INDEED a sad day for cinema in India and Pakistan as everyone mourns the passing of one of the last surviving stars of the Hindi film industry's 'Golden Age', which lasted from 1940 to 1960. Mohammed Yusuf Khan, known professionally as Dilip Kumar, was suffering from age-related health complications. He was 98-years-old. Popularly known as the 'Tragedy King' of Bollywood, Kumar was a remarkable method actor


who could not be confined to genres.



GRAZIA: Could you tell us a little about how you realized you were gifted? When was it, how old were you, where were you?

SHEETAL DEWAN: I did always feel different from everyone else growing up. As a child I could sense more, the dogs in the house were my close companions and still choose to be. My mother always narrates an incident of when I was two years old, I held onto my aunt's tummy and said "kaka hai" nobody knew that she was pregnant. I have also been told that I had an imaginary friend I would speak to in a language no one understood and making me sleep was apparently a nightmare for everyone in the house as all I wanted to do was talk the night away - not to my parents but rather to the walls and the ceiling.

Growing up was eventful, animals were my confidants and humans felt like aliens. People were and till today are a jigsaw puzzle to me, one that I feel the need to solve for no one else but myself.
